- -Kelly Burns-Gaorian is the new Annual Dinner Team leader
- -Kristine Ditano, a member, has volunteered to be the barn/trainer liaison encouraging barn/trainer participation in the chapter's activities
- -The chapter approved, and a \$1000 check was sent to the Oklahoma State University Vet School to help with the costs related to medical care for the horses injured in the recent Tornados that devastated parts of Oklahoma.

#### **Charity selection:**

BOD reviewed the list of potential charities that was developed earlier in 2013. Horse's Honor is still a favorite, however, Connie is going to look into Canter Horse Rescue and Cecilia will look into Oakdale Equine Rescue to see how they match up to our criteria -- we want to select the group that uses the highest percentage of monies donated directly for the animal's welfare and not administrative costs.

**Venue:** Casa Real at Ruby Hill Winery, Livermore – booked March 21<sup>st</sup> (see attached photos)

**Donation:** 50% of the net profits to the charity and increase the amount if we can. Kelly suggested we might assign the profits from certain Auction items to be fully donated, i.e., The Wine Table, Jewelry, etc. which might encourage attendees to bid higher.

BOD agreed to this donation percentage.

  sponsorship benefits to better fit the chapter's abilities to provide the said
  benefits (i.e., programs are difficult to produce since we don't have a graphic
  designer with the extra time needed to produce) Other ideas for benefits
  include: flash drives pre-loaded with URL links to all of the sponsor's
  websites, simplify the programs to include a list of sponsors only since ads
  are so difficult to procure.
- Ann is finishing up inserting sponsor links on the website She has provided Cecilia with a list of sponsors that need follow-up

- Continuation of sponsor outreach Cecilia will do the 2014 letters to current sponsors, however, she does not want to be responsible for getting new sponsors. The BOD will search for a person to take on this role.
- Vicki to schedule a clean-out the shed day with Patrick Adams. We need to see if there are any gift time items that we can offer to sponsors, at horse shows, etc. Suggested date is Sunday, June 23 from 9-1. Vicki will advise as to Patrick's response.
