ADDENDUM "A" - VIRTUAL HORSE SHOW RESEARCH

Two options:

We hire judge, negotiate price with him/her, pay VHS \$10/ride + Stripe fee (approx. \$1.50/ride) We set entry fee and keep the rest

VHS hires judge, VHS pays us \$10/ride less Stripe fee. Entry fee would be determined based on VHS cost but seems to run around \$45/ride

Judge cost – S (all levels) \$20/ride

R (T-4) \$15/ride

R (T-2) \$10/ride

We can suggest a judge if there is one that we particularly want. VHS will approach to hire

Show Dates: everything is open right now except April – Sue Curry Memorial Show

Pick a weekend. Entries close Saturday afternoon of the weekend of the show. Show ends at 4PM Sunday. Riders have until Monday evening to send video.

Scholarships: VHS has a scholarship available from Sue Curry Memorial Fund for adult

amateurs. Pays for entry fees.

Western Dressage: Can open show to Western Dressage to increase participation.

\$35 recognition fee payable to WD organization.

Participation levels: Most shows attract about 25 participants. New venues can be 30-60. Santa Barbara chapter shows are 35-65. They include Western Dressage. Also have a high point prize for their chapter members.

• Clinic Option: Participants ride a test and get scores plus additional comments and training tips from judge at the end of the ride. Option to do a "free ride" instead of a test to work on specific issue. 15 minute ride with comments

and training tips at the end.

Judges charge \$50 per session for clinics. VHS arranges and pays the chapter \$10/ride. Any FEI judge can do this. No conflict with USDF/FEI rules.

Dec 10 to EOM VHS website will be refreshed for 2022. 2021 activity will be removed.

ADDENDUM B - Potential partnerships presented by the SF/P Chapter Decision – it was agreed to help support them with publicity and call for volunteers but not to join in organization of events

5. We have conducted virtual test riding clinics with limited attendance. If your chapter is interested, we could explore these again. Due to the virtual clinic format we are able to access top tier judges

6. We have discussed a clinic with Sabine after World Cup 2022. She is focused on competition right now so we have not confirmed anything yet.

7. We have discussed a potential clinic like the FEI trainers conference that would feature both trainer and judge so participants can learn how to connect the feedback from the judge to their training.
